Delivered over 18 months plus 120 hours of work in an aged care facility.\*

## **Entry Requirements**

Learners must already hold a CHC33015 Certificate III in Individual Support and be working in the aged care sector.

Prior to enrolling your proficiency in language, literacy and numeracy will be assessed to determine any support requirements.

You will need to have access to a computer with an internet connection.

## **Delivery Method**

This qualification is delivered via a combination of online, face-to-face and work based learning.

To gain your qualification, students are required to complete a minimum 120 hours of work in an aged care setting.

Work-based learning purposefully merges theory with practice to provide students with real-life work experiences where they can apply academic and technical skills and develop their employability.

## **Course Price**

The Higher Level Skills Program provides eligible individuals with access to a subsidised training place in selected Certificate IV level qualification and above in selected skill sets. Eligibility applies.

The Student Co-Contribution Fees are a student's contribution to the cost of training and assessment services provided by Look Now Training.

The current contribution fees for this qualification are:

- Non-concessional = \$250
- Concessional = \$150

# **Eligibility Criteria**

- Must be a Queensland resident
- Must be aged 15 years or over, and no longer at school
- Must be an Australian or New Zealand citizen or Australian permanent resident (including humanitarian entrants), or a temporary resident with the necessary visa and work permits on the pathway to permanent residency
- Must not have, or be enrolled in, a certificate IV level or higher qualification (not including qualifications completed at school and foundations skills training).

Higher Level Skills Program is funded by the Queensland Government.
